The environmental and economic impacts



Japan, host country of the Kyoto Protocol, abandoned its target to cut down CO2 emissions and extensively uses fossil fuel (imported) to produce its electricity.

Due to coal and gas import, electricity cost increased by 15 to 20% for industry and household.
